- Turned professional November 1981, at the age of 28
- Defeated Tim Witherspoon to become W.B.A. champion

- Established the North Carolina Boxing Commission
- Became an ordained minister in 1996
- Founded a non-profit organization “Champion for Kids” to provide scholarships to high school students
- Became an author of “M.A.D. Make a Decision”
